

Completion of the Critical Social Justice Module

All students who first registered for undergraduate programmes in 2024 and 2025 are reminded that they must complete the Critical Social Justice Course (CSJ) module before they can achieve Degree Completion (DC).

Please note the following, in accordance with the University's BR10 Rule:

- All students who will be registering for the first time in any of the undergraduate programmes in CHS are required to register for and complete the CSJ module before they can achieve DC.
- Students who registered for undergraduate programmes in the College of Health Sciences (CHS), for the first time in 2024, and are in their final year this year will not qualify for Degree Completion if they have not completed the CSJ module.
- Any student who registered for any undergraduate programme in the College of Health Sciences (CHS), for the first time in 2024 or 2025, and has not yet registered for or completed the CSJC module is reminded to do so in 2026.
